# South Korea\_ Quarantine/ Immigration regulation for crew change under Covid-19

## 1. Quarantine regulation for crew changes

#### 1) On-signers

#### NO ISOLATION REQUIRED FOR ALL ENTRANTS

- (C-3-11 visa) the visa is not required from 08 Jun entrants.
- EDI (Proof of seafarer), OKTB is required in prior to arrive Korea.

## 2) Off-signers

## NO ISOLATION REQUIRED FOR ALL ENTRANTS

- Off signers shall take PCR/RAT test at any office near their hotel within 3 days from disembarked date.
- (China) 3 days required for PCR test at China approved hospital.

# 3) General Crew Change

## < General regulation>

• (PCR report) The on-signers must have valid PCR test report, certifying that the person is **tested within** 48 hours from their departure flight.

#### ■ Restrictions ■

- The crew change cannot be performed during cargo operations, but at anchorage.
- The vessel with embarked crews from ports of <u>Russia</u> or <u>Philippines</u> cannot perform crew change in Korea ports in 14 days of embarkation date.

## ■ Validity of PCR reports ■

- All PCR negative test reports must show the test method as 'NATTs(Nucleic acid amplification tests, RT-PCR, LAMP, TMA, SDA, NEAR) which can be confirmed by Korean guarantine office.
- Each report must contain each crew's information. The report with crew's list is not being accepted.
- The information in below must be shown in the PCR test report;
  - 1. Name
  - 2. Date of birth or Passport number.
  - 3. Test Name & method
  - 4. Test result
  - 5. Test date
  - 6. Test result issue date
  - 7. Official stamp or signature from the test report issuing organization
