

INSTRUCTIVE FOR ARRIVING AT TOCUMEN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT DURING CURRENT COVID-19 PANDEMIC PERIOD

<u>NOTE:</u> Please be guided that you might face delays at the airport during the process due to ongoing security measures and restriction at the Airport. Sailors could be retained until the officer collecting the visas return from outside of the Terminal.

- 1. Look for an Immigration officer and advise that you are a seafarer.
 - a. Have your passport and seaman's book ready to present to the Immigration officer.
- 2. Request your Panamanian Incoming Visa for Seafarers.
 - a. If you are from Cuba, India or China, the Escort from Immigration Authorities will retain your personal documents as passport, seaman's book, and Visa.
- 3. Once clearing Immigration procedures, you must go outside the airport as the drivers are not allowed to go inside.

Recommendations for traveling during COVID-19.
