

India – Crew Changes Standard Operating Procedures



Restrictions placed on travel for passengers travelling from India - 1

- 1. USA- The US has restricted travel from India, with some exceptions, after the US CDC updated India's Covid-19 assessment from Level 3 to Level 4. The travel ban does not apply to U.S. citizens or permanent residents and their spouses. The 04 May 2021 travel ban from India to the U.S. impacts nonimmigrants and noncitizens of the United States that have been in India for any or all of the last 14 days. Foreign sea crew members are exempt subject to local embassy guidelines.
- 2. UK- From 4am on Friday 23 April, visitors who have been in or transited through India in the previous 10 days cannot enter the UK. British and Irish nationals, and third country nationals with residence rights in the UK arriving in England from India will be required to quarantine in a hotel. Different requirements apply for arrivals into Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. - 3. France India remains on the French "Red List". You can only travel to France if you have pressing grounds for travel. The list of pressing grounds is set out in the certificate of international travel drawn up by the Ministry of the Interior.
- 4. UAE- The United Arab Emirates has further extended restrictions on travellers from India till 21 July 2021. This includes passengers on all flights on national and foreign carriers, as well as for transit passengers coming from India. Only transit flights travelling to the UAE and bound for India will be allowed to land, the UAE said in a statement. This decision also includes extending the suspension of entry for travellers who were in India in the 14-day period prior to arrival in the UAE. However, passengers exempted from this ban include UAE citizens, diplomatic missions appointed by the countries, official delegations, businessmen travelling on chartered flights and those with golden residency.
- 5. Hong Kong- Any passengers who have been in Brazil, India, Indonesia, Nepal, Pakistan, The Philippines, South Africa or the United Kingdom for more than two hours in the past 21 days will not be permitted to enter Hong Kong. Seafarers' exemptions on case-by-case basis.
- 6. Singapore- International airline operations between India and Singapore remain suspended. Singapore has banned all long-term pass holders & short-term visitors, who have travelled to India within the last 14 days from entry / transit via Singapore. All travellers who have travel history to Bangladesh, India, Nepal, Pakistan, and Sri Lanka within the last 21 days will not be allowed to transit through Singapore.
- 7. Canada- has suspended all flights from India until 21 July 2021. However, Cargo flights from India will continue. Passengers who travel to Canada from India via an indirect route will need to obtain a pre-departure negative COVID-19 molecular test result from a third country before continuing their journey to Canada. Travellers who have previously tested positive for COVID-19 must provide proof of a positive COVID-19 molecular test conducted between 14 and 90 days prior to departure, instead of a negative COVID-19 molecular test. For seafarer's application via IRCC portal is required. https://www.cic.gc.ca/visit-visiter/en/instructions-ircc-portal
- 8. Australia- Australia's borders are currently closed and entry to Australia remains strictly controlled. Facilitated commercial flights from India to Australia have resumed. You will need to undertake a rapid antigen test prior to boarding flights, in addition to the PCR test already required before travel to Australia. Any requirement of flight operation will need special permission from the Embassy. Travel to Australia is available if you are exempt or you have been granted an individual exemption. Seafarer exemptions have not been clarified fully.
- 9. New Zealand- Travel to New Zealand remains strictly controlled. India has been designated a very high-risk country. Only New Zealand citizens and their immediate family members travelling from high-risk countries are eligible for entry to New Zealand. Other travellers, including New Zealand residents, can enter only if they spend 14 days outside a very high-risk country before their arrival in NZ. Transit through a very high-risk country is excluded from the 14-day requirement. No exemptions indicated for seafarers.



Restrictions placed on travel for passengers travelling from India – 2

- 10. Philippines The Philippine government extended until 15 July the rule barring travelers from India, Pakistan, Nepal, Bangladesh, Oman, UAE and Sri Lanka from entering the country. The rule also applied to persons who had traveled to those countries within 14 days from arriving to the Philippines. Exemptions apply to Merchant seamen with a 9(c)-visa issued by the Philippines This will have to be checked individually at local embassies.
- 11. Iran- Banned travellers from India indefinitely from April 26. In the case of certain authorised travellers, they are subject to 14 days isolation and testing on arrival.
- 12. Kuwait- Banned flights from India. Visas are not issued upon arrival at the airport nor are they available electronically in advance for individuals seeking to travel to Kuwait.
- 13. Indonesia- Will not issue Visas to any foreigners who have been in India during the past 14 days basis circular by Directorate General of Immigration No. IMI-GR.01.01-0873. Exemptions for Ships crew available on case-to-case basis.
- 14. Bangladesh- India falls under the Group "A" countries indicating restrictions for entry of Indians. All travel has been banned until further notice. Cargo movement is permitted.
- 15. Israel- Ban extended to 01 Aug 2021. Israel Ministry of Health requires all passengers arriving from India to go into isolation, including passengers with valid vaccination or recovery certificates. Passengers from "red" countries with a high rate of covid-19 will not be allowed to visit Israel. India remains on Red List.
- 16. Cambodia Has placed a ban on travelers from India. The country does not permit travelers who have been to India as far back as three weeks.
- 17. Taiwan Except for Taiwanese citizens, all those who had been in India in the 14 days prior would be barred from entering its territory, while returning Taiwanese face 14 days in centralised quarantine facilities. Exceptions will be considered on a case-by-case basis for emergencies and on humanitarian grounds.
- 18. Qatar- Travellers returning from India, Nepal, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Pakistan and the Philippines must under-go a mandatory quarantine, regardless of their vaccination or anti-body status. Arrivals from these countries must undergo 10-day quarantine in a dedicated quarantine facility, or 14 days if quarantined at a Mekhaines facility.
- 19. Bahrain- Starting from the 25 June, Bahrain's Civil Aviation Affairs (CAA), in coordination with the National Taskforce for Combatting the Coronavirus, has announced that entry of travelers coming from the countries listed on the red list (India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Nepal, and Vietnam) will continue to be suspended on all flights.
- 20. Maldives- Maldives has suspended until 15 July 2021, the issuance of tourist visas for Travelers originating from South Asian Countries (Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Nepal, Pakistan, and Sri Lanka), including those with a transit time exceeding 24 hours and have a travel history to the above stated countries within the past 14 days, effective 13th May 2021. As of now, the government has announced that borders will open for all countries from 15 July 2021.
- 21. Germany- Effective 25 June, entry into Germany from India is banned as it has classified India as a Virus Variant country. Exception of travel ban granted to citizens of Germany, Permanent resident, transit person only staying at airport, cargo flights, person travelling due to urgent humanitarian reasons and person travelling by the order of IAEA, UNO. Eligible individuals will have to take two diagnostics tests- one before and one after the flight, and quarantine for 14 days in Germany.
- 22. Italy- Entry to Italy is prohibited for people coming from India, Bangladesh & Sri Lanka or who have stayed in the countries in the preceding fourteen days, with the exception of Italian citizens registered as residents in Italy since before April 29, 2021



Restrictions placed on travel for passengers travelling from India – 3

- 23. Spain As of 07June21, arrivals from countries outside the European Union and Schengen Area have been permitted to enter Spain, provided that they have been vaccinated. In order to be allowed to enter the country, the vaccine should be approved either by the EMA or the WHO. It is expected that stricter rules will come into force shortly due to the Delta Variant spreading quickly through Europe.
- 24. Netherlands —Travellers from India continue to be subject to the EU entry ban. This means they may enter the European Union (including the Netherlands) only if they qualify for an exemption for the travel ban. Seafarer Exemption available.
- 25. Switzerland Travel from India to Switzerland is now allowed. However due to the Indian travel ban and no air bubble arrangement between the two countries, it is still not possible to travel.
- 26. Belgium Till further notice entry to the Belgian territory will be forbidden to anyone who has been in India during the previous 14 days, apart from Belgian citizens and holders of a valid residence permit for Belgium. Seafarer exemptions available.
- 27. Oman- The Supreme Committee dealing with COVID-19 and the Civil Aviation Authority has decided to extend the suspension of entry into the Sultanate until further notice for those coming from 14 countries, including Sudan, Egypt, Philippines, Lebanon, South Africa, Brazil, Nigeria, Tanzania, Ghana, Guinea, Sierra Leone, and Ethiopia, the United Kingdom, India, Pakistan, Bangladesh and travelers who have been in or transited through these countries in the previous 14 days prior to their request to enter the Sultanate.
- 28. Djibouti- As a preventative measure, international travel to and from Djibouti has been suspended until further notice.
- 29. Nigeria Non-Nigerian passport holders and non-residents who visited Brazil, India or Turkey within fourteen (14) days preceding travel to Nigeria, shall be denied entry into Nigeria. This regulation, however, does not apply to passengers who transited through these countries.
- 30. Japan India remains on the list of countries that are subject to denial of permission to enter Japan unless special exceptional circumstances are found.

All international scheduled commercial passenger flights to and from India will remain suspended until 31 July 2021.

SIGN ON

- 1. Foreign Nationals / Indian Nationals Crew Change Permitted at Berth as well as at Anchorage for vessel calling at Mundra Port.
- 2. Foreign national Sign on is permitted subject to having valid Transit VISA on hand
- 3. Advance permission upon receipt of crew details, to be obtained from Local Authorities. (Immigration / FRRO / Port / Customs)
- 4. As per latest updates, joining crew must bring a COVID19 negative report from hometown. Upon Landing at Ahmedabad Airport, crew must undergo COVID19 PCR test inside Airport.
- 5. Joiners must possess COVID19 negative report in order to join a vessel at Mundra. The lab will take the samples for testing for crew members. The designated lab details are as follows:
- Unipath Specialty Laboratory, Sanoma Plaza, 102, 1st Floor, Sheth Mangald Road, opp. Parimal Garden, Ellisbridge, Ahmedabad, Gujarat 380006.
- Supratech Micropath Laboratory & Research, Neuberg Supratech, Ground Floor, Kedar Builiding, Opp. Krupa Petrol Pump Parimal Garden, Gujarat 380006.
- 6. After giving test samples to laboratory, Crews can commence their further travel from Ahmedabad to Mundra.
- 7. Once the negative result arrives, the same along with other documents will be presented to authorities for sign on procedure. RT-PCR Results are now taking 24-48 Hours after tests are conducted due to the surge in COVID positive cases locally. This may cause delays or in some instances may make crew changes not feasible. This will have to be established on a case-by-case basis based on the date of crew change. Please contact our local office for clarity.

Note:-

- 1.For Foreign National Joiners, PCR test report shall be conducted from the Airport Only as the Lab operates from the Ahmedabad Airport also.
- 2.Lab operates 24 x 7 at Ahmedabad Airport.
- 3.Immigration / Customs are available 24 x 7 at Mundra for Crew change formalities.

SIGN OFF

- 1. Currently Indian National & Foreign National Sign off can be done during vessel call at Mundra.
- 2. Advance permission upon receipt of crew details, to be obtained from Local Authorities in order to perform the disembarkation formalities of Crew Members. .
- 3. Seafarer to be cleared by Immigration authority.
- 4. Upon Disembarkation, Crew required to be isolated in Hotel and once his Covid Test done, upon having negative result, further Sign off Formalities to be completed.
- 5. Until test reports are received, the seafarer shall be kept under a quarantine facility approved by the Port and State Heath Authorities. RT-PCR Results are now taking 24-48 Hours after tests are conducted due to the surge in COVID positive cases locally. This may cause delays or in some instances may make crew changes not feasible. This will have to be established on a case-by-case basis based on the date of crew change. Please contact our local office for clarity
- 6. Foreign national Sign off would be granted up to 07 days TLP (Temporary Landing Permit VISA) by local Immigration / subject to his flight schedule.
- 7. The transit pass for such movement by road, for the seafarer and one driver, will be issued by local authorities of the Government of the State / Union Territory where the seafarer disembarks.
- 8. The transit pass (to and fro) will be issued for a fixed route and with specified validity and will have to be adhered to strictly. Such transit pass would be honoured/ allowed by the authorities of the State/ Union Territory along the transit route.
- 9. Ship owner / RPS agency to ensure the following for taking seafarer home:
 - a. Vehicle being used for travel is properly sanitized and PPE (masks, hand gloves) and sanitizers made available for driver and seafarer.
 - b. Driver and seafarer to maintain social distancing requirements as per MoHFW guidelines.

- 1. Vessels coming from affected countries are issued Limited Free Pratique. PHO will board the vessel on arrival and grant clearance for crew Change. CDHO (Chief District Health Officer) permission not required now, however Negative test reports required.
- 2. As per the latest updates, advance permission from FRRO is mandatory for undertaking Crew Change at Mundra Anchorage.
- 3. Force Majeure revoked on 21st Oct 2020. Indian & Foreign National Crew Sign On/off permitted at berth, Sign on subject to valid PASSPORT & SEAMANS book on hand and Transit visa for Joiners.
- 4. No requirement of 14 days quarantine for vessels arriving from Chinese ports. As per DGS Order 35 of 2020 dated 17.12.2020 and Addendum 4 to DGS Order No. 04 of 2020, it has been decided that the mandatory quarantine period of 14 days mentioned at Para 13 of the DGS Order 04 of 2020 shall not be insisted upon.
- 5. For Off-signers, It takes 24-48 hours to have the PCR report Upon submission of Samples as Lab Representative normally arrives from Ahmedabad to take the Sample of Off-signers.

- 1. Permitted even at OTB (Outer Tuna Buoy) / No COVID19 testing facility available locally / Approved ICMR Lab authorized collection centre at Kandla will arrange collection of Swab Sample of Crew Members and send it to Ahmedabad for testing.
- 2. As per latest updates, joining crew must bring the COVID19 negative report from hometown. Once more, crew must go through COVID19 PCR test at Gandhidham. RT-PCR Results are now available 24 Hours after tests are conducted.
- 3. For Sign on, regular procedure is to be followed., after having Covid Negative report done at Gandhidham.
- 4. Crew change is allowed on vessels which are granted "LIMITED PRATIQUE" by PHO.
- 5. As per the latest updates, for crew change at Kandla OTB, henceforth, FRRO permission also to be obtained along with other necessary permissions. The issue has been taken up with the concerned authorities.

SIGN OFF

- Permitted even at OTB. (FRRO Permission to be obtained for Anchorage Crew Change).
- 2. From collection of samples till receipt of report takes about 24 hours.
- 3. Crew disembarkation can be done only after having Covid Negative Report.
- 4. Crew change is allowed on vessels which are granted "LIMITED PRATIQUE" by PHO.
- 5. Foreign national Sign off would be granted up to 30 days TLP (Temporary VISA) by local Immigration / subject to his flight schedule.

- Vessels coming from affected countries / arrived at Kandla from foreign port within 14 days of last port are issued limited free pratique. PHO will board the vessel on arrival and grant clearance for crew Change. CDHO (Chief District Health Officer) permission not required now, however Negative test reports required.
- · As per the latest updates, advance permission from FRRO is mandatory for undertaking Crew Change at Kandla Anchorage.
- Force Majeure revoked on 21st Oct 2020. Indian & Foreign National Crew Sign On/off permitted at berth and Anchorage, Sign on subject to valid PASSPORT & SEAMANS book on hand and Transit visa for Joiners.
- No requirement of 14 days quarantine for vessels arriving from Chinese ports. As per DGS Order 35 of 2020 dated 17.12.2020 and Addendum 4 to DGS Order No. 04 of 2020,

GENERAL RULES

- 1. No Crew change will be allowed prior to cargo operations even at anchorage.
- 2. Only 09 Passenger can be accommodated in a single tugboat
- 3. Outside vehicles are not permitted to enter inside the terminal premises due to Covid 19 precautionary measures. Each agent has been allowed only one vehicle for movement inside the terminal.
- 4. In view of the above limitation, crew movement will be carried out by a single car inside the terminal, hence there will be a delay in movement of crew from Terminal gate to Jetty

SIGN ON

- Crew Change operation is permitted from 0800 Hrs. to 1700 Hrs. only.
- 2. On signer to carry out Covid-19 test before departure from their hometown.
- 3. On signer will go through Covid 19 test after reaching Jamnagar & sample will be dispatched to Ahmedabad Laboratory.
- 4. Covid 19 test result will take 24 Hrs. to 48 Hrs. & during this time they will be accommodated in a hotel approved by the District Heath office.
- 5. Sign on permission will be granted by all concerned authorities after their Covid test is negative.
- 6. On signer should reach Jamnagar 2 to 3 days prior arrival of vessel in port.
- 7. On-signing Seafarers shall wear PPE (full body suits) and to maintain social distancing
- 8. Handing over / mingling of signing-on crew shall not be allowed with off-signing crew
- 9. Nearest Airport is Jamnagar, 2nd Alternative- Rajkot & 3rd Alternative Ahmedabad
- 10. All documents must be sent well in advance in order to obtain permission from concerned authorities
- 11. Foreign national Sign on is permitted subject to having valid Transit VISA on hand. Upon arrival in India, the Crew must board the vessel within 3 days (w.e.f. arrival at First Indian Airport)

SIGN OFF

- 1. Crew Change operation is permitted from 0800 Hrs. to 1700 Hrs. only.
- 2. Off signing Indian & Foreign nationals will be quarantined for 7 days at a district health authority approved hotel (quarantine period will count from last port departure date). After Covid negative report received, the off signer will be permitted to leave Jamnagar jurisdiction.
- 3. Local immigration will issue travelling permit to foreign national which will be valid for 30 Days

- 4. In case the COVID-19 test comes positive, vessel agent must inform all concerned authorities i.e., Port Health Authority, Port Administration, Health Dept., Govt. of Odisha and make arrangement for the patient to be treated as per guidelines / rules of MOHFW in force.

- Vessels arriving from COVID affected countries are issued Limited Free Pratique.
- No requirement of 14 days quarantine for vessels arriving from Chinese ports. As per DGS Order 35 of 2020 dated 17.12.2020 and Addendum 4 to DGS Order No. 04 of 2020, it has been decided that the mandatory quarantine period of 14 days mentioned at Para 13 of the DGS Order 04 of 2020 shall not be insisted upon.
- · Indian and Foreign Crew Sign On/ Off possible at berth. After Landing in India, Crew need to join the vessel within 72 hrs.
- RT-PCR Results are now taking 48-72 Hours after tests are conducted due to the massive surge in COVID positive cases locally. This may cause delays or in some instances may
 make crew changes not feasible. This will have to be established on a case-by-case basis based on the date of crew change. Please contact our local office for clarity.



Dhamra – State of Orissa

Crew Change Not Permitted

SIGN ON

- The Shipping agent will liaise with Port Medical Officer (PMO) Dhamra Port, Port Control Dhamra Port, Bhadrak FRO and Customs with the requisite details of the crew planned for sign on.
- 2. The shipping agent will arrange COVID-19 test at ICMR approved Lab Bhubaneswar/ Cuttack. While awaiting test report the seafarers to avail paid quarantine facility at Bhubaneswar. On receipt of negative test report seafarer will travel to FRO, Bhadrak for sign on stamping on their passport.
- 3. The Shipping agent will arrange the stay of the seafarer at the designated hotel as notified by DM, Bhadrak while awaiting to board vessel.
- 4. Agent to submit COVID-19 test reports along with valid DGS approved medical certificate of on signers to PMO for clearance.
- 5. Agent to submit COVID-19 test reports along with requisite documents to Customs for clearance. Customs baggage check will be carried out at Vessel/ Jetty prior boarding vessel.
- 6. Sign on crew to wear full body protection suit during their transit through Port till arrival on board.
- 7. In case the COVID-19 test comes positive, vessel agent must inform all concerned authorities i.e., PMO, Port Control, Health Dept. GoO and make arrangement for the patient to be treated as per guidelines/rules of MOHFW in force and directives of local administration.

SIGN OFF

- 1. The Shipping agent will liaise with the designated hotel (Jasmine Jyoti Resorts private Ltd, Basudevpur), Port Medical Officer (PMO) Dhamra Port, Port Control
- 2. Dhamra Port, Bhadrak FRO and Customs with the requisite details of the crew planned for sign off.
- 3. The Shipping agent will arrange the stay of the seafarer at the designated hotel as notified by DM, Bhadrak on arrival and arrange for collection of sample for COVID-19 test as per the protocol of State Govt. or arrange ICMR approved Lab personnel to visit vessel for swab collection. If the ship's last foreign port call is within 14 days then collection of sample for COVID-19 test as per protocol, will be carried out post completion of quarantine period.

On Board swab collection by ICMR approved Lab personnel:

- Agent to arrange ICMR approved Lab personnel with full body protection as per guidelines for swab collection on board. On receipt of negative report agent to arrange for disembarkation of off signers.

SIGN ON

- 1. Appeal to Port Nodal officer with detail program of Sign-on with name and ID documents.
- Appeal to Immigration officer with detail program of Sign-on with copy of Passport/Seaman Book & Visa copy with Immigration stamp page at 1st Indian airport
- 3. To arrange quarantine centre for On-Signer crew at Kolkata, approved by H&FW, Govt. of West Bengal under intimation of Nodal officer and Immigration.
- 4. Co-ordinate with Port for COVID test of On-Signer crew at Kolkata.
- 5. After getting the negative report same must be submitted to Immigration and after verification of report, they will grant permission to sign-on.
- 6. After completing above formalities crew can proceed to Haldia for sign-on.
- 7. Customs formalities will be done after reaching the crew at Haldia.
- 8. Embarkation of crew is allowed only after the boarding formalities of the concerned authorities are completed.

SIGN OFF

- 1. Appeal to Port Nodal officer with detail program of Sign-off along guideline given by DGS like Maritime Health declaration, Temperature list, Individual health declaration etc.
- 2. Appeal to Immigration officer with details of DGS guideline and copy of passport and seaman book at least 72 hours before of the crew disembarks from vessel.
- 3. After getting permission from Immigration off-signer crew can disembark from the vessel to proceed Quarantine centre at Kolkata.
- 4. TLP with validity 3 days will be issued by FRRO subject to prior intimation.
- 5. Crew will stay at Kolkata quarantine centre under intimation of Nodal officer and Immigration till test result.
- 6. Passport and Seaman Book must be deposited with FRRO, Kolkata.
- 7. After submission of negative test result and From C (will be collected from hotel) FRRO will release off signers PP+SBK to hand over off signer for repatriation.
- 8. Customs will clear the off-signers baggage upon disembarking the crew from ship or they will clear the baggage after obtaining negative COVID Test report.
- 9. Customs charges for supervision of baggage will incur from the time of crew disembarkation until the scheduled flight date.

- Vessels arriving from COVID affected countries are issued Limited Free Pratique.
- Indian & Foreign National Sign Off / ON Permissible. Foreign Crew permitted sign on permitted subject to being in possession of a valid passport, Transit Visa & Seaman book. (NO CREW CHANGE PERMITTED For Chinese, Pakistani, Sri Lanka, Ethiopia, Iraqi ,Nigeria ,Somalia and Afghanistan)
- After landing in India, Foreign Crew need to join the vessel within 72 hrs. Please ensure crew lands India on a flight that is just past midnight in order not to lose a day. Coastal vessel crew sign on & Sign off COVID test is mandatory at Kolkata.
- RT-PCR result is expected within 24-48 hrs after tests are conducted due to the surge in COVID positive cases locally. This may cause delays or in some instances may make crew changes not feasible. SIGN ON

- 1. The Ship Owner / Master / Vessel Agent should send an e-mail to nodal officer wherein a detailed Programme of Sign On crew with the name and ID document.
- 2. Agent to arrange for stay of the seafarer at a quarantine lo cation at Kolkata, approved by H&FW, Govt. of West Bengal under intimation to the Nodal Officer. List available at H&FW website: www.wbhealth.gov.in Covid-19 test will be carried out by authorized lab arranged by port at Kolkata on payment, at the quarantine location itself. No test can be carried out at Haldia. The seafarer to continue at Quarantine location till outcome of the result.
- 3. The report of the Covid-19 test to be shared with the Nodal officer of KDS / HDC.
- 4. If a Seafarer is COVID-19 positive, relevant guidelines of MoHFW, Govt. of India to be followed and Nodal Officer of KoPT to be informed.
- 5. The cost of the COVID-19 test, transportation of the Seafarer and their arrangement for stay at approved Quarantined safe location to be borne by the Ship Owner / Master / Agent.
- 6. It is the responsibility of the Ship Owner / Master / Vessel Agent to keep PHO informed about such Sign On / Sign Off of seafarer at Kolkata Port.

SIGN OFF

- 1. As regards Sign Off, the Maritime Declaration of Health along with other required documents to be submitted to Nodal Officer as well as PHO and obtain immigration clearance. In case of Seafarers coming from foreign port, Quarantine of 14 days to be observed at a safe location approved by H&FW, Govt. of West Bengal under intimation to Nodal Officer.
- 2. The concerned Seafarer to be transported to Quarantine location as specified in Para-2 under heading of "Sign On" by Ship Owner / Master / Vessel Agent for conducting COVID-19 test in an Ambulance both for Kolkata and Haldia vessels, observing other relevant guidelines. Till the outcome of the Covid-19 test, the seafarer to continue at the quarantine location.
- 3. The report of the Covid-19 test to be shared with the Nodal officer of KDS / HDC.
- 4. If a Seafarer is COVID-19 positive, relevant guidelines of MoHFW, Govt. of India to be followed and Nodal Officer of KoPT to be informed.
- 5. The cost of the COVID-19 test, transportation of the Seafarer and their arrangement for stay at approved Quarantined safe location to be borne by the Ship Owner / Master / Agent.
- 6. It is the responsibility of the Ship Owner / Master / Vessel Agent to keep PHO informed about such Sign On / Sign Off of seafarer at Kolkata Port.
- 7. Ship owner / RPS agency to send confirm flight e-ticket and ensure for taking seafarer home.
- 8. TLP with validity of up to 1 (one) month and a one-time fee of USD 40 may be given by Immigration Officer, keeping in view the requirement of the seafarer.

- RT-PCR Results are now taking 24-48 Hours after tests are conducted due to the surge in COVID positive cases locally. This may cause delays or in some instances may make crew changes not feasible. Port Blair – Andaman and Nicobar

Crew Change Permitted

SIGN ON

- Crew must arrive Port Blair minimum 03 to 04 working days in advance, prior to vessel arrival.
- 2. Covid Test of all passengers including Sign on crew members is carried out at the Airport upon payment of necessary charges (approx. Rs.4,000). It may be prudent for the crew to carry sufficient cash, as they will have to pay it upfront, prior they meet the agent's representative.
- 3. Time required for getting the report is approximately 48 hours.
- 4. Sign on Crew need to be guarantined in Hotel till report is received.
- 5. After receiving NEGATIVE report, crew to be can be taken directly to Immigration / Customs depending on vessels berthing schedule for further formalities.

SIGN OFF

- Vessel arriving from any foreign port, off-signers will have to be quarantined for a total period of 14 days, from the vessel's departure date from last foreign port as per DG Shipping guidelines.
- 2. On completion of 14 days quarantine, off signers shall undergo a COVID-19 test.
- 3. Till the time test reports received, the crew shall be kept under quarantine facility (Preferred Hotel).
- 4. Time required for getting the report is approximately 48 hours.
- 5. Once crew tested negative, Owners / RPS must make E-pass arrangements for crew disembarkation.

- Vessels arriving from COVID affected countries are issued Limited Free Pratique.
- PORT BLAIR being a Union Territory, Local Administration and Defence permissions are mandatorily required. It takes around 10 working days, as these are granted from New Delhi.
- · Agency appointment letter, Crew list, P&I, Maritime Declaration of Health, Ship Registry and Vessel particulars are required for applying permissions.
