### ADVISORY

#### REVISED GUIDELINES PER IATF-MEID RESOLUTION NO. 151-A, SERIES OF 2021

Relative to IATF-MEID Resolution No. 151-A dated 28 November 2021, please be advised of the following travel-restricted countries/territories/jurisdictions, and revised travel restrictions guidelines, effective 28 November 2021 until 15 December 2021:

#### I. TRAVEL-RESTRICTED COUNTRIES/TERRITORIES/JURISDICTIONS

1.	South Africa	8.	Austria

## II. PASSENGERS ARRIVING FROM TRAVEL-RESTRICTED COUNTRIES/TERRITORIES/JURISDICTIONS

- Passengers coming from or who have been to travel-restricted countries/ territories/jurisdictions and/or "Red List" countries/jurisdictions/territories within the last fourteen (14) days shall NOT be allowed entry, EXCEPT Filipinos returning via government-initiated, non-government-initiated and Bayanihan repatriation flights, subject to health and quarantine requirements for "Red List" countries/jurisdictions/territories.
- ALL arriving passengers coming from, or who have been to the above travel-restricted countries/jurisdictions/territories within the last fourteen (14) days, arriving before 0001H of 30 November 2021, shall undergo an absolute fourteen (14)-day facility-based quarantine and be required a negative Reverse Transcription-Polymerase Chain Reaction (RT-PCR) result taken on the 7<sup>th</sup> day (date of arrival as Day 1).
- III. PROVIDED, (1) those who transited or who have a mere lay-over at the airport of travel-restricted countries/jurisdictions/territories (lay-over only at the airport and with no immigration admission at said countries); and (2) those NOT coming from travel-restricted countries/jurisdictions/territories, may be allowed

entry subject to relevant resolutions of the IATF-MEID and applicable testing and quarantine protocols.

- IV. Passengers coming from "Green List" countries/jurisdictions/territories shall follow testing and quarantine protocols for "Yellow List" classification<sup>1</sup>.
- V. The entry of fully vaccinated non-visa required nationals under Executive Order No. 408, s. 1960, as amended, and coming from Green list countries / territories / jurisdictions, pursuant to IATF-Resolution No. 150-A dated 25 November 2021, is temporarily suspended.

Existing guidelines for arriving Section 9(e) visa holders and crew member/s shall still be observed.

The foregoing is without prejudice to the exercise of the mandate of the Bureau of Immigration in Arrival and Departure formalities.

1. For Fully Vaccinated Passengers	
With negative RT-PCR test taken within seventy-two (72) hours prior to departure from country of origin;	<ul> <li>Facility-based quarantine until release of negative RT-PCR test taken on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day;</li> <li>14-day self-monitoring (date of arrival being the first day)</li> </ul>
B. Without negative RT-PCR pre-departure test	<ul> <li>Facility-based quarantine until the release of negative RT-PCR test taken on the 5<sup>th</sup> day;</li> <li>Home quarantine until the 10<sup>th</sup> day from the date of arrival</li> </ul>
<b>2.</b> For <u>unvaccinated, partially vaccinated or individuals whose vaccination status cannot be validated</u>	<ul> <li>Facility-based quarantine until the release of negative RT-PCR test taken on the 7<sup>th</sup> day;</li> <li>Home quarantine until the 14<sup>th</sup> day from the date of arrival</li> </ul>
