

III. RED LIST COUNTRY

Latvia

<u>All passengers coming from or who have been to the "Red List" country within</u> the last fourteen (14) days <u>shall not be allowed entry</u>, **EXCEPT**, returning Filipinos via government-initiated, non-government-initiated, and Bayanihan repatriation flights subject to health and quarantine protocols:

- Returning Filipinos shall undergo a fourteen (14)-day quarantine [10-day facility-based and home quarantine until completion] and be required an RT-PCR test on the seventh day, with the date of arrival being the first day; and
- Those who transited or who have a mere lay-over at the airport of "Red List" country (lay-over only at the airport and with no-immigration admission at said country) shall not be deemed as coming from this country.

IV. PROOF OF VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

Further, for validation purposes of vaccination status, proof of vaccination requirements is also revised:

Passengers' Categories

 Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs), their spouse, children, and parent/s traveling with them, vaccinated abroad

Proof of Vaccination Status

In lieu of Philippine Overseas Labor Office certification, they may present the digital/ physical vaccination certificate of the foreign government where they were vaccinated without the need of a reciprocity agreement.

IV. PROOF OF VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

Further, for validation purposes of vaccination status, proof of vaccination requirements is also revised:

Passengers' Categories

- Non-OFWs vaccinated in Philippines or abroad
- · Foreigners vaccinated in the Philippines

Proof of Vaccination Status

ANY of the following:

- a. VaxCertPH digital vaccination certificate;
- Bureau of Quarantine (BOQ) / World Health Organization (WHO)- issued International Certificate of Vaccination or Prophylaxis (ICV);
- c. National/state digital certificate of the foreign government where they were vaccinated abroad and has accepted VaxCertPH under reciprocal arrangement.

Foreigners vaccinated abroad

a. WHO- issued ICV;

OR

 b. National/state digital certificate of the foreign government which has acepted VaxCertPH under a reciprocal arrangement;

Testing and quarantine requirements per IATF-MEID Resolution No. 144-A dated 14 October 2021 (and BI Advisory dated 15 October 2021) shall remain in effect.

Existing guidelines for arriving Section 9(e) visa holders and crew member/s shall still be observed.

The foregoing is without prejudice to the exercise of the mandate of the Bureau of Immigration in Arrival and Departure formalities.
