### **Port Dues Incentive Scheme for Green Maritime Fuel-related Vessels**

2. We are pleased to announce the launch of the Port Dues Incentive Scheme for Green Maritime Fuel-related Vessels (the "Incentive"), effective from 16 June 2026 to 15 June 2029. The Incentive aims to reduce the port dues for green maritime fuel-related Ocean-going vessels (OGVs) to help lower the cost of transitioning to green maritime fuel-related OGVs and narrow the price gap between traditional maritime fuels and green maritime fuels.

3. Under the Incentive, OGVs visiting Hong Kong and conducting any specified operations may apply for the incentive. The amount of the incentive is equivalent to 25% or 50% of the port dues paid during the visit in Hong Kong, including port facilities and light dues, anchorages dues, buoy dues and fee for a port clearance permit.

4. We invite all shipping agents to review the eligibility criteria, application procedures, and supporting documents requirements outlined in the Introduction for Port Dues Incentive Scheme for Green Maritime Fuel related Vessels via the links below:


